
Required Attire & Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Required Attire:

- **Scrubs:** A dedicated pair of scrubs to wear only in the lab is required at all times when dissecting cadavers or viewing pro-sections.
- **Close-toed shoes:** Most students “sacrifice” an old pair of shoes/sneakers for use only in the anatomy lab. We suggest that students store these dedicated shoes in their locker in the anatomy lab locker room. Sandals or open-toed shoes are not to be worn in the lab.

Required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- Nitrile gloves
- Gown
- Shoe covers if you don't have a pair of dedicated lab shoes that NEVER leave the locker room.
- Protective eyewear: Regular prescription eyeglasses are sufficient eye protection.

Note: Gloves, gowns, and shoe covers will be provided for you. We suggest that you purchase your own protective eyewear if you don't wear prescription eyeglasses. The lab maintains a limited supply of well-used safety glasses.

Required when using power tools or hand tools (e.g., hammer, chisel, rib cutter)

- Face shield or goggles
- Surgical mask when using a surgical (Stryker) saw cutting bone
